Work On Main Runway At Bradley Completed

WINDSOR LOCKS

— The major reconstruction of the main runway at Bradley International Airport was completed Monday, officials said.

The \$17 million project was paid for with state and federal money, and included repaving, rebuilding of electrical ducts, an upgraded water main, new wiring and new lighting. The runway carries 60 percent of the flights in and out of Bradley.

Officials said the project was finished on time and under budget. The runway had been closed since April 13, and it reopened today.
